The BRC Team Endurance Event is being hosted and organised by Endurance GB for the 2011 season.

This Team Event is an opportunity for you to come along and try endurance riding in the company of your friends and colleagues. Teams can be made up of three to six riders. You don't need any special equipment, particular breed or type of horse to get started, just you, your horse and your normal riding tack.

Qualifying rides of 30 to 35km (20 miles) are being held at most EGB rides, very often passing over private land. Riding Club Teams can enter as many qualifying rides as they wish, with their best score going forward to a League Table for their Region.

The top two teams in each of the nine Regions will be invited to compete in the Final at The College Ride in Bedfordshire on 18 September. Some wild card places in the Final will also be awarded at the discretion of the national organisers.
