BRC Senior/Juniors HT 100+ Qualifier SJ: 110cm XC: 1m Speed: 520mpm	Open to mixed or separate teams of 4 members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. BRC Junior HT 80 Qualifier SJ:75cm XC: 80cm Speed:435mpm	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses or ponies may be registered with BE but must not have gained any points nor have been placed in the first six in any BE 90 or completed a BE 100 or above in the current or previous calendar year at the close of prelim entry. BRC Junior HT 90 Qualifier SJ: 85cm XC: 90cm Speed: 450mpm	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses or ponies not to have gained any BE points at the close of prelim entry. Test: BRC HT90Q	£196 per team £49 per individual
BRC Junior HT 100 Qualifier SJ: 1m XC: 1m Speed: 475mpm	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses or ponies not to have gained more than 20 BE points at the close of prelim entry. Test: BRC HT100Q	£19 per team £49 per individual

All entrants must pay a prelim entry of £51 per team and £13 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Prelim entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries <u>www.britishridingclubs.org.uk</u> or online entries can be made via the BHS bookshop <u>www.britishhorse.com</u> Late prelim entries may be accepted with a late surcharge of £20 per team or pair and £10 per individual. Late entries cannot be guaranteed and may only be considered at the discretion of the organiser, whose permission must be sought first.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees already paid cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be considered from the original close of prelim entry.

All hats must have a visible orange BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing.

Your horse must have up to date Influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook.

Protective Headgear

'As per current BRC rule book and must be tagged with an orange tag before competitors may ride. Hats may be tagged at the competition.

Body Protectors

A body protector is obligatory in all cross-country competitions and is strongly recommended in show jumping competitions. A BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has been manufactured in the year 2000 or after must be worn. Body protectors should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturer's instructions.

If a rider chooses to wear an airbag style body protector it must be worn over a permitted body protector and if activated, must be deflated or removed before continuing. Hybrid Air-jackets are permitted.

Riders wearing Exo Body Cage protectors must inform the secretary at all events.

Medical armbands

Medical armbands are mandatory for any type of cross-country competition. These must be worn on the arm and not on the leg. They should be filled in with the relevant competitor's details. Spot checks will be carried out in the collecting ring.

Tack and Dress Rules

Please make sure you adhere to tack and dress rules found in the current version of the BRC rules. The full 2017 version is available to download online. If you have a query regarding these rules, please ring BRC on 02476 840593.

Please ensure you bring a number bib - numbers will be provided on the day.

CONDITION OF ENTRY – EACH TEAM TO PROVIDE A MINIMUM OF 1 HELPER PER TEAM FOR THE DAY - DAY – IT WOULD BE HELPFUL IF PREFERRED ROLE COULD BE STATED ON THE ENTRY FORM I.E DRESSAGE WRITING, STEWARDING, JUMP JUDGING, ALONG WITH CONTACT DETAILS. ROLES WILL BE ADVISED BY THE ORGANISER IN THE WEEK LEADING UP TO THE EVENT.
