It is anticipated that this day will run where possible under the ARRIVE COMPETE LEAVE process, although we are aware that some will be entered in more than one class/ sharing transport. With this in mind there are to be no spectators at this event, each rider may bring one person to assist them, in addition juniors may be accompanied by a parent, and para riders with an extra support person if required.

If you are staying for more than one class please return to your vehicle in between your riding times.

Those sharing transport for horses should consider whether they need to travel in a separate vehicle themselves to be compliant with current covid guidance, and this also applies to those coming to assist riders.

Please remember to bring hand sanitiser and masks for use if needed,*

Scores will be posted on <u>www.ridingclubresults.co.uk</u> as soon as they are available. Rosette / score sheet distribution will be confirmed nearer the time.

Catering information will be posted nearer the date of the event.

Flu Vaccinations

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook, (correct FV history including having been vaccinated within the previous 6 months and 21 days prior to the competition). The flu certificate / passport must accompany the horse to the event but it is unlikely that we will be able to check in our usual manner due to the covid situation. All those in who appear to be in a qualifying position will need to email a scan (preferred) or a picture of their horses vaccination history no later than 6pm on Monday 17th May.

Hats

All hats must have a visible aqua BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground, to show that they meet the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day in the yard to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. Please remember to observe covid requirements with regard to social distancing and mask wearing if the weather means that officials need to be based under cover. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.
